

## **Social Difficulties Inventory**

Social Difficulties Inventory (SDI-21) is a twenty one item questionnaire developed to assess everyday problems experienced by cancer patients.

The Social Difficulties Inventory (SDI-21) is a twenty one item questionnaire developed to assess everyday problems experienced by cancer patients. Responses to all items are on a 4 point scale ranging from "0" no difficulty to "3" very much difficulty. SDI-21 scores may be reported in three ways:

- 1. Individual item scores
- 2. Three subscale scores (Everyday living, Money matters, Self and others)
- 3. Social Distress (SD-16) score
